1. I, the Parent, am responsible for providing nutritious meals and snacks while my child is enrolled at Far Horizons Montessori School in accordance with school policy.

Mail by June 1st

- Registration Fee (\$50), First Tuition Payment– if outstanding (Make check payable to Far Horizons Montessori School.)
- Lunch Milk Fee (\$15), Friday Pizza Luncheon Fee (\$31.50 optional) (Make check payable to Isabel Rodriguez.)

What to Bring

- Completed Summer Application / Enrollment Forms including the Student Release Form, Emergency Medical Authorization Form, & Parental Agreement (To download these forms, please visit the Parents' Page on our web site: www.farhorizonsschool.com)
- GA Immunization Certificate (for all new campers), and a GA Vision, Hearing & Dental Screening Certificate (for campers five years old and older)
- Signed Tuition and Fee Schedule
- Change of clothing for all children (Place a complete change of clothing, including two pairs of underwear, in a gallon Ziploc bag and label it with your child's name.)
- Nap linen for all children less than 5 years old (Place a fitted crib sheet and a light-weight thermal blanket in a gallon Ziploc bag and label it with your child's name.)

Other Notes

- Toys, dolls, sunglasses, costumes, balloons, money, small erasers, candy & gum should be left at home.
- Please label everything!!!! This includes, shoes, shirts, underwear, towels, cups, Rubbermaid, etc. Check out www.mableslabels.com
- We spend a considerable amount of time outdoors, so please apply sunscreen and bug spray to your child each morning. We will not be able to apply this individually at school.
- Uniforms are not required for summer camp. Tennis shoes or rubber-soled shoes are recommended. Crocks, as well as flip-flops or other open-heeled shoes, are not permitted because they pose a tripping hazard.

Snack & Lunch

- Snack
 - Snack should be placed in a paper bag and contain one nutritious food item, one nutritious drink, and two paper napkins. (See the Parent Handbook on our Parents' Page for details.)
- Lunch
 - Lunch should be placed in an insulated lunch bag or box along with a cloth napkin, to be used as a place mat, and a paper napkin for wiping fingers.
 - State guidelines require that your child's lunch contain one protein, two vegetables or fruits, and one bread or equivalent. Additional food is optional. We provide at least 4 oz. of milk daily.
 - Please do not send your child with Go Gurts (squeezable yogurt), or desserts.
 - For children under five, please see our Parent Handbook for additional details on food safety tips.

Tuition & Fees

- Tuition statements will not be sent out. Tuition payments are due June 1st and July 1st. Payments should be mailed to our post office box: Far Horizons Montessori School / P.O. Box 71273 / Albany, GA 31708. Tuition received or postmarked after the fifth of each month will be assessed a \$25.00 late payment fee.
- A \$45.00 returned check fee will be charged to your account by Far Horizons Montessori School for any checks returned for "insufficient funds".

Super Fridays

- Pizza luncheons and water play will begin the first Friday of camp and continue each Friday throughout summer camp.
 - On Fridays, bring your snacks as usual.
 - For campers participating in our pizza luncheons, we will provide the pizza & fruit.
 - Campers should wear their swimsuit and bring a towel to sit on or use for drying. Girls should wear shorts over their swimsuits and boys should wear shirts over

- their swimsuits.
- Campers will need a change clothes after water play. Each camper should have a bag of extra clothes in his/her cubby. Wear tennis shoes, or water shoes.

Pick-Up & Drop-Off

- Campers may be dropped off ten minutes before their camp session and should be picked up immediately after their scheduled camp session. A late pick up fee (of a dollar a minute) should be paid at time of service whenever campers are picked up 15 minutes or more after their scheduled camp session.
- Parents, please form two parallel carpool lines for 3:00 dismissal. PLEASE BE PATIENT WITH THE CARPOOL PROCESS. SAFETY IS OUR PRIMARY CONCERN.
- Please stay in your car. Any parent needing to speak to a teacher should park and wait for the end of dismissal. Teachers generally have an ongoing camp session even after 3:00 and, therefore, may need to get back to you later.
